SHARE YOUR MEDICAL RECORDS

One year prior to your date of transfer, sign paperwork granting permission for Radys to share your medical records with the Center for Bleeding & Clotting Disorders at UC San Diego.

Three to six months prior to your date of transfer, call the UC San Diego CBCD and speak with the patient coordinator. Have your SSN (social security number) & insurance card ready to set up your UC San Diego Medical Record Number. You can sign up for MyChart to access your medical records and communicate with your medical providers at UCSD through the messaging system.

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FILE GHPP PAPERWORK*

ONLY if you have been on CCS (California Children's Services) or California Kids Care (CKC) then you need to apply for GHPP insurance (Genetically Handicapped Persons Program).

To make sure your insurance coverage will not lapse, your medical appointments and factor medication can continue to be covered, **file 3-months prior to your 21st birthday.** Visit the GHPP website for instructions on to apply: <http://www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/ghpp>.
